Description:

Born in 1988 in Saint Julien en Genevois, Ugo Cérina graduated from Beaux-Art School in Aix-en-Provence. As a starting point inside the show, there is a mention of the word monument, a Rodin's sculpture depicting the writer Balzac. The artist appropriates the initial use of the piece as to offer his own monument. The installation involves a painting of urban ruins and a concrete sculpture covered with plexiglass. This installation shifts the rules of monumental practice as an allegorical reminiscence of the post-modern.
