Description:

In astrophysics, the ergosphere is a region located outside the outer event horizon of a rotating black hole but the fragment above from a Borges' poem felt particularly fitting to illustrate the feeling of this series of pieces.

For this work, the artist used fragments of bones and ashes from animals that perished in a forest wildfire in the town where he grew up in Mexico. To affix the materials to the canvas, he used an ancient technique called encaustic, made from copal resin, beeswax and blackbone pigment.
